### **Accreditation of St. Peter Academy**

Mr. Galligan is happy to announce that the process to achieve candidacy for St. Peter Academy with the *New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC)*, the region's leading school accreditation agency, has begun! The first step of the process, our application, is underway with insight from directors of the NEASC Commission on Independent Schools. (There are four commissions of the agency: Colleges & Universities, Public Schools, International Schools, and

Independent Schools; our institution falls within the last category). This application is slated to be submitted in February, with an anticipated meeting between our school administration and directors of the Commission on-site at St. Peter Academy slated for this Spring. Undoubtedly, this is exciting news and another testimony to the fact that our school is on the move!

### **School Enhancements**

We are happy to report that *every student* in Grade Kindergarten 2 through Grade 6 has been provided with school-issued iPads or Chromebooks; additionally, every teacher and classroom is now utilizing school-issued laptops to enhance our educational and communication initiatives. Mr. Galligan has also applied for grants to enhance the security and surveillance of our school.
