Dear St. Peter Academy Parents and Guardians,

We have been listening closely to Governor Charlie Baker in anticipation of an eventual re-opening of the economy and, perhaps most importantly, our school building. In preparation for a safe and most welcome return to St. Peter Academy, we have formed a coalition of community members who are meeting weekly as a committee to discuss a reopening plan that ensures all essential elements are met. These include but are not limited to: (1.) the safety and well-being of our students, faculty, and staff; (2.) an adherence to local, state, and national guidance; and (3.) ensuring that **ALL** students can be with us every day in school.

As of right now, we anticipate a three (3) phased re-opening process which entails: welcoming back our Early Education (Toddler) Program students in June, the reinstatement of our summer program in July, and a return to in-person classes in September. Of course, these plans rely heavily on announcements and directives from the government. The situation remains fluid based upon medical guidance and best practices at any given time. We will continue to keep our community informed of any changes or updates once they become available to us.
