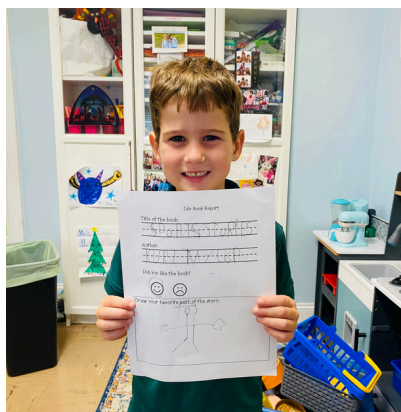


Mission:
