Program At-A-Glance

Schedule: The PreK School Year Program

follows the calendar for the academic school year. Students may enroll for three or five full days or five half days. Full day programming runs from 7:40am-2:55pm, half day programming begins at 7:40am and ends at 12:00 noon. The PreK Year Round Program is a 50-week program that runs from 7:40am-5:30pm.

Curriculum: PreK classrooms implement Eureka Math, the Foundations Literacy Program, and the nationally recognized “Opening the World of Learning” (OWL) Curriculum, OWL “provides the strongest research- based early literacy curriculum and seamlessly weaves solid content that captures children’s natural curiosity about the world into an activity-centered day. The curriculum covers all domains of learning: Language and Literacy, Social Studies, Science, Mathematics, The Arts, Physical Development.” Additionally, the St. Peter Academy Universal SEL Curriculum, Second Step is a leading research based social-emotional learning curriculum that fosters students’ emotional intelligence, empathy, and problem solving.

Enrichment: Physical Education, Spanish, Music, & S.T.E.M. twice weekly.
